Ghostwriting

When you don't have the time or the expertise to write your novel or non-fiction book, I can write it for you. I'll work closely with you to bring your ideas to the printed page. Your book will be written based on your input and in your voice, and you will retain full copyright. The book will be sold or offered under your name alone.

My only goal is to help you bring *your* vision and *your* voice to your readers.

In over a decade of service, I've had the honor to write books in many genres including:

• Non-fiction: Self-help, business, finance, personal improvement, health, spirituality, nutrition and food, and memoirs. Many of my clients' books have become Amazon category best sellers. My clients include global Fortune 500 companies, entrepreneurs, and emerging authors with an idea they want to share. A non-fiction book should inspire, entertain, and move the reader to take positive action to improve their life or their part of the world.



• Fiction: Thrillers, horror, historical novels, science fiction, mysteries, and even business books written as fables featuring animal characters. You'd be surprised to learn how many top-selling novels have been ghostwritten!

Ghostwriting is always priced on a flat rate, per-word basis. I usually write and deliver in milestones of 5,000 words each. I sign no contracts; it's always "pay as you go." I do not get involved with graphics or cover art; writing is a highly specialized occupation, and like most good writers, I focus like a laser on the writing.

Comprehensive Editing

When you have a nearly completed book, I'm happy to provide editorial services. I'll read the entire document and help you to organize and present your thoughts as effectively as possible. I may suggest adding material or deleting passages that aren't effective. In this process it pays to have an open mind, because many authors are sensitive about their work and it can be difficult to be objective. I'm very easy to work with. You do not want an editor who is bossy and won't explain why he or she favors certain changes. It's your book and your name on the cover!

Editing prices range from two cents to five cents per word. I will always give you a price in advance. Then, as the work progresses through the milestones, you review the results, and only when we are in agreement should you continue. There are never any surprises. Here are the various levels of book editing:

Developmental edit. I work in partnership with you to develop and shape the text and the content. It does not include line editing or proofreading.

Copy edit. I will look at every aspect of your document. Does it make sense? Is it readable? I may ask to re-write sections or suggest changes. The "five Cs" summarize the copy editor's job:

Make the copy CLEAR, CORRECT, CONCISE, COMPREHENSIBLE, and CONSISTENT. I also provide formatting services so that your book or document has a professional look.

Line edit. I ensure that every sentence reads properly, is grammatically correct, and has no typos, but I do not address larger issues of theme or continuity.

When deciding questions of grammar and punctuation, I use the *Chicago Manual of Style*. It is a highly regarded industry standard. But there are others, and you may specify which style you want to follow. No matter which style you choose, the key is *consistency*. For example, if you choose to write out numbers below ten (one, two, three, as opposed to 1, 2, 3), this should be done consistently throughout the document. But in cases where there is some ambiguity, the bottom line is always readability: does it make sense?

Proofreading. This is the last step where we find the little mistakes that are hiding in plain sight. To be honest, you cannot proofread a book too many times. Think of it this way: in a novel with 80,000 words, there are roughly 500,000 individual characters and spaces. Half a million – and each one needs to be perfect! My goal is for your manuscript to have zero mistakes.

I will always work closely with you to preserve *your* voice and *your* personal vision. Your story is unique, and whether your style is chatty or hard-boiled or academic, I will always be in tune with your expressive voice.

As a published editor or ghostwriter of hundreds of non-fiction books and novels, many of which are category bestsellers on Amazon.com, I'm uniquely positioned to guide you through the exciting process of writing your book!
